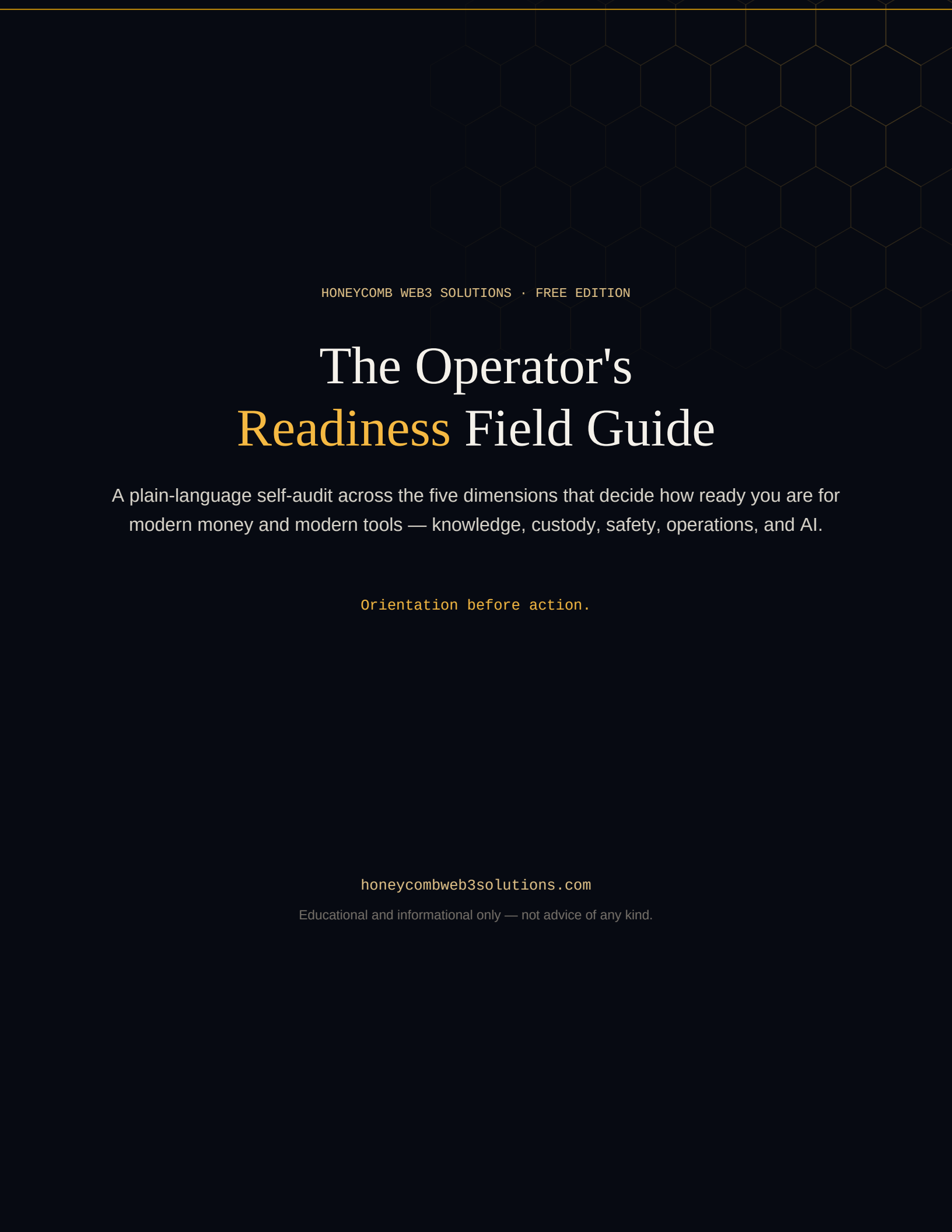

Knowledge.

Clarity is a skill, and it compounds. You do not need to know everything — you need to know enough to ask the right question before money or reputation moves. Check what is already true:

- I can explain, in one plain sentence each, what a blockchain, a wallet, and a stablecoin actually are.
- I know the practical difference between an exchange holding assets *for* me and a wallet I control myself.
- I know that “trustless” does not mean risk-free — it just removes a single operator.
- When someone claims a coin or product is “backed,” I know that claim has to be checked, not assumed.
- I can name at least one thing that makes a transaction fail (fees, wrong network, congestion).
- When I meet a new term, I have a reliable place to look it up in plain English.

Custody.

Custody is the question underneath every other question in digital assets: *who holds the keys?* Operators who can answer it calmly make better decisions everywhere else. Check what is already true:

- I know that whoever holds the keys controls the assets — and that self-custody means me, alone, with no recovery hotline.
- My recovery phrase (if I have one) lives offline — never typed into a website, never photographed, never shared with anyone, including “support.”
- Before sending a meaningful amount to a new address, I send a small test first and confirm receipt.
- I know which network an asset is on before I move it, and I match the network on both ends.
- I keep a simple written record of which accounts and wallets exist, so nothing important lives only in my head.
- I have rehearsed the motions — copy, paste, verify, send — somewhere that nothing real was at stake.

Custody confidence is built in rehearsal, not in the moment. That is exactly why the simulator exists — expensive mistakes, practiced for free.

Safety.

Good safety is not paranoia — it is a small set of calm habits that make the common traps simply bounce off. Most of them take minutes to adopt and last for years. Check what is already true:

- I reach the sites I use through my own bookmarks or a typed address — verified once, reused forever — not through search ads or links sent to me.
- I know that real systems never create urgency around my keys, and unexpected “support” messages get disengagement, not replies.
- Before approving anything in a wallet or app, I read what it actually grants.
- My important accounts use strong, unique passwords and two-factor authentication.
- My devices install updates promptly, and I know which devices touch money.
- The people around me — family, team — know the two golden rules: nobody legitimate asks for your recovery phrase, and urgency is a signal to slow down.

Operations.

This is where operators separate from spectators. Operations means that if a payment, a vendor, or a tool entered your business today, there would be a written way to handle it.

Check what is already true:

- If my business accepted a digital payment today, I could reconcile it — reference, asset, network, timestamp, and an export path into my books.
- I evaluate new vendors on substance — custody model, track record, failure states, exit path — not on price and vibes.
- I have a written path for a stuck or failed payment: check status, hold fulfillment, document, escalate.
- I know which decisions I would take to a qualified professional — legal, tax, accounting — before acting.
- Access to business accounts and tools is mapped: I know who can touch what, and what happens if a key person is unavailable.
- I revisit this checklist on a schedule, because readiness drifts when nobody is watching it.

- I can name two tasks in my week that AI could shorten, and one where human judgment must stay in charge.
- I have a sense of where AI fits my business — and where it simply doesn't, yet.
